# BRUCE BIADA | 1953-2023

On May 16, 2023 our dear Bruce beamed up to his spaceship. Bruce was a constant source of inspiration and love to his devoted students, friends and many fans throughout the world. His artistic excellence and brilliance was unique and rare - always seeking the best, most creative and authentic in his legendary teaching style and uniquely stylized choreography.

Bruce was universally respected and beloved as a person, and as a consummate artist. His sense of joy, humor, and purpose in everything in life was a hallmark of his beautiful spirit. A generous, kind, caring and patient soul, we can never forget his contributions to our community. He is greatly missed by all who had the honor of knowing him and the thrill of witnessing his unique artistic genius.

#### A NOTE FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR:

When going through Bruce's personal possessions this summer, I came across a letter I wrote to Bruce 23 years ago when I graduated high school. I could not believe he kept it all these years! The words of seventeen year old me still ring true today. When thinking of what to write in this program, I felt sharing this letter might resonate with many of you. For those of us lucky to dance with Bruce, I know we all feel forever changed.

#### Dear Bruce,

Where do I begin with a man who cannot fit a description because he is way too interestingly complicated? He makes the dream a reality, he motivates and captures the audience, and his soul is filled with vibrant colors and an endless giving heart which never ceases to pour generosity, love, and compassion. Before I even knew how to tap, I wanted to join Bruce's class. In my mind, he was the guy who always made the "strange" dances. As soon as I took my first Bruce class, I realized just how happy I was to be a part of what his mind and body could create.

Bruce, I cannot even begin to describe how much you have taught me. I have been incredibly blessed with an individual who isn't afraid to let his soul dance openly in every light and dark corner of the universe. Your choreography astonishes me, enlightens me, and best of all becomes me. I am so lucky and proud to have gotten the opportunity to become a part of you through dance. I see a most amazing heart inside of you which is constantly growing and becoming more with every piece you create. You are my teacher, my friend, and my inspiration. I owe so much of my dancing career to you. You have taught me that it isn't just the movement, but the idea behind the motion. With every memory and dance that I have performed, you have become a part of me. I love you more than words can say...if you watch me dance, I hope you see that the love I have for you is always present.

This could never be goodbye, for you are always a part of me. What you have made me become in my life, I will always be.
